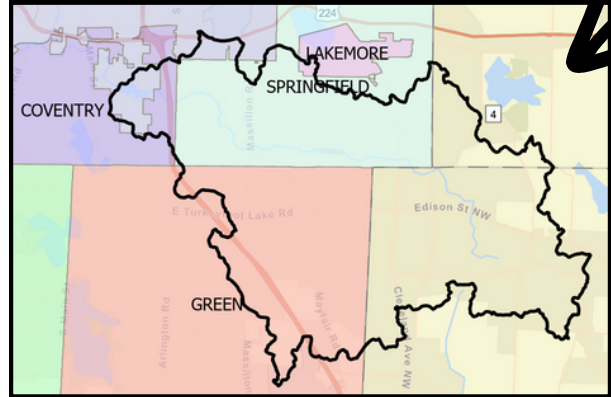


Headwaters Tuscarawas

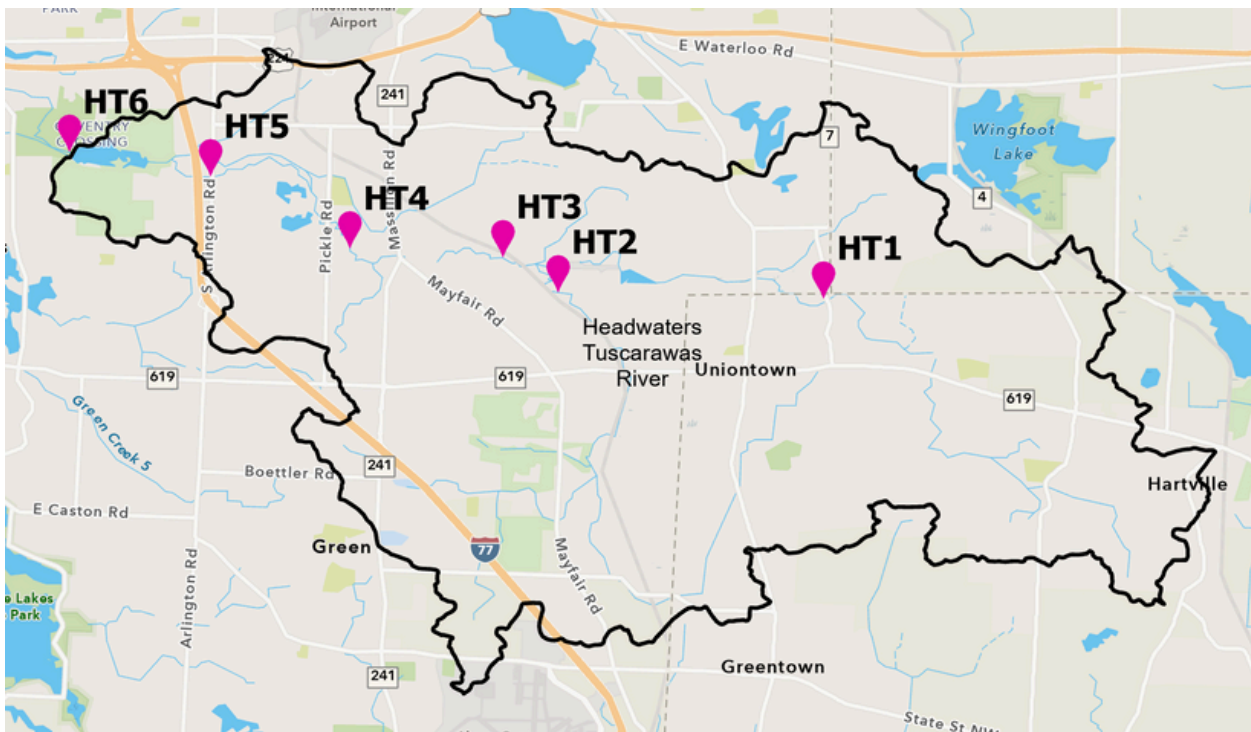
Thank you for sampling with us! Our program would NOT be possible without you!

Background: The Headwaters Tuscarawas River drains approximately 35.79 square miles (over 22,000 acres!) in Summit, Stark, and Portage Counties. It connects to the Tuscarawas River (one of the largest in the state) and eventually all our water makes its way to the Gulf of Mexico.



Watershed Concerns:

Low oxygen, sedimentation, habitat degradation, bacteria, pollutants, abnormal flow
