WHY CARE?

Household hazardous waste (HHW) pose a real threat to our surface and ground waters. When sent to the landfill, contaminants from these toxic products either seep into groundwater or are carried off site by storm water runoff. It is a major safety concern worldwide and can pose a threat to human health. It can also present hazards to children and pets if left around the house.

-  Automotive products
-  Paints
-  Cleaners
-  Batteries
-  Fluorescent light bulbs
-  Garden chemicals
-  Household cleaners
-  E-waste (TVs, tablets, etc.)

TIPS

- Follow product instructions for proper use and storage.
- Read product label for proper disposal instructions.
- Never store hazardous products in food containers.
- When leftovers remain, never mix household hazardous waste with other products.
- Be careful with empty containers due to residual chemical that might remain.
